Binar has acquired Dynamis AB based in Karlskoga. The company markets SensActive[®], the self-developed and patented automation technology for material handling.

The system performs identification of components and instructs a robot to pick unsorted materials directly from pallets (Bin-picking) which has not previously been possible. The technology provides significant productivity improvements in engineering- and production processes, is the only one of its kind on the market and is expected to set a new standard in engineering industry's material handling. SensActive[®] admits an almost noiseless material handling. Furthermore, the system saves a lot of space and is very flexible which makes it possible to quickly adjust production.

SensActive[®] is based on intelligent laser sensors that use three-dimensional scanning technology to recognize and identify components and their shapes. The system can also carry out quality control in production checking for any measures discrepancies.
